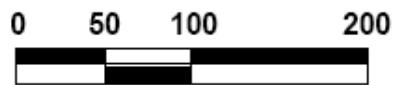
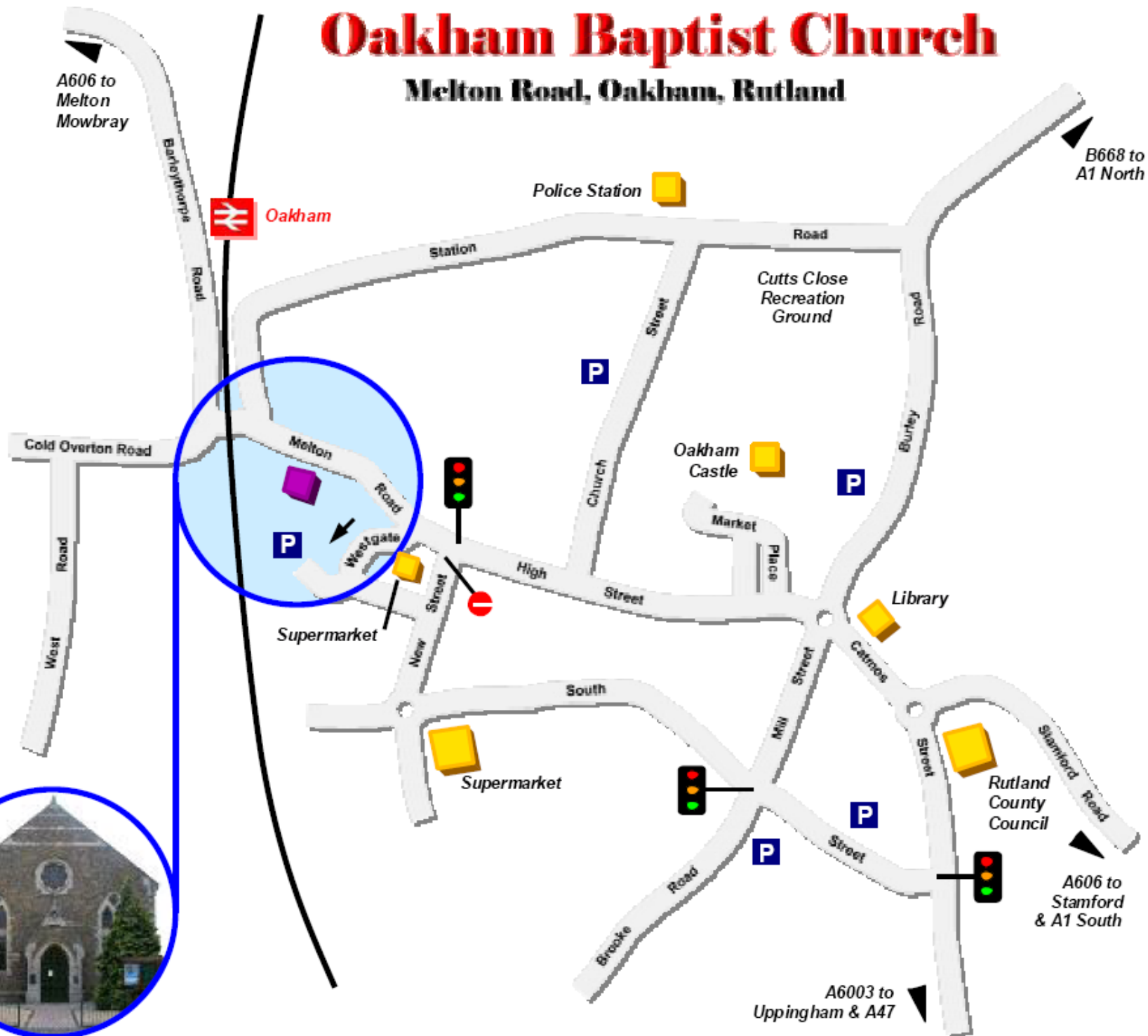


Oakham Baptist Church

How to Get to Oakham Baptist Church...



By Car:

From Melton Mowbray:

Take the A606 from Melton Mowbray to Oakham, passing through the villages of Burton Lazars, Langham and Barleythorpe.

When you get to Oakham follow Barleythorpe Road round to the left and go over the level crossing into Melton Road.

Drive past Oakham Baptist Church (which is on the right) and turn right into Westgate, just before the Somerfield supermarket and the traffic lights with New Street and High Street.

Take the next right into St Anne's Close (not marked on map) which is sign-posted to Westgate car park.

The rear entrance to Oakham Baptist Church is accessible from the car park.

From Stamford and the A1 (South):

Take the A606 from Stamford to Oakham, passing through the villages of Empingham and Whitwell.

When you get to Oakham follow Stamford Road to the mini-roundabout and take the second exit (right) into Catmos Street.

At the next mini-roundabout take the second exit (straight on) into High Street and continue to the traffic lights with New Street and Melton Road and continue straight on.

After the traffic lights and the Somerfield supermarket, take the first left into Westgate.

Take the next right into St Anne's Close (not marked on map) which is sign-posted to Westgate car park.

The rear entrance to Oakham Baptist Church is accessible from the car park.

From the A1 (North):

Take the B668 from the A1 to Oakham, passing through the villages of Greetham, Cottesmore and Burley.

When you get to Oakham follow Burley Road to the mini-roundabout and take the third exit (right) into High Street and continue to the traffic lights with New Street and Melton Road and continue straight on.

Follow the rest of the directions as described for "From Stamford and the A1 (South)."

From Uppingham and the A47:

Take the A6003 from Uppingham and the A47 to Oakham, passing through the villages of Preston and Gunthorpe.

When you get to Oakham follow Uppingham Road (not marked on map) to the traffic lights with South Street and Catmos Street and continue straight on.

At the mini-roundabout with Stamford Road take the first exit (straight on) continuing on Catmos Street.

Follow the rest of the directions as described for "From Stamford and the A1 (South)."



By Train:

Oakham railway station is less than a 5 minute walk from Oakham Baptist Church. There are regular services from Leicester and Peterborough mainline railway stations.



By Plane:

The nearest airport to Oakham is Nottingham East Midlands which is approximately 50 minutes drive away (35 miles). London Heathrow is approximately 2 1/2 hours drive away (110 miles).
