You are probably not surprised, but we are very sad to have to tell you that, following the government's recent announcements, we will not be able to meet at all as a church family on Sundays or mid-week. These precautions are to protect the most vulnerable members of our church family. We are in uncharted territory. These are unprecedented times.

John 14:27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

We have three main priorities at this time:

- **Keep safe**
- **Keep connected**
- **Keep providing help and support.**

Keep safe

The only way we can protect all members of our church family is to keep our distance for the time being. A number of us will be self-isolating anyway because of being unwell or being vulnerable because of age, ill-health or poor mental health.

Keep connected

We are still making plans but we hope that the Life groups/small groups will be the first point of contact for most of us. We will keep in touch with:
