I am reminded as I am writing to you, in these days of communicating without meeting that we are all "letters" that God sends out into the world to be read by anyone that we come into contact with. Paul wrote in his second letter to the Corinthian church (even though their relationship had been a bit challenging): *"You yourselves are our letter, written on our hearts, known and read by everyone. You show that you are a letter from Christ, the result of our ministry, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the Living God, not on tablets of stone but in tablets of human hearts."*

And indeed, many of you may be reading this on a "tablet". Remember that every time we communicate, in whatever way, during this time of separation, that it can be Christ's word to the one we are sharing with, if we share what is in our hearts.
